



SIZING A VALVE

REMEMBER:

When ordering the correct size valve, measure across the opening of the valve you are replacing. After getting the diameter of the valve, deduct about $\frac{1}{4}$ " for the proper size valve.

Thus, if the opening measures $\frac{3}{4}$ " across, and you deduct $\frac{1}{4}$ " - the valve would be a $\frac{1}{2}$ " valve.

Said another way, a $\frac{1}{2}$ " valve will have approximately a $\frac{3}{4}$ " opening.
True Size Chart Below.
